NEWARK AREA LEGISLATORS HOLD ANNUAL LEGISLATIVE WRAP-UP

For over a decade, state legislators from the Newark area have held an annual Legislative Wrap-up for residents in the Newark area soon after the end of the legislative session. This year's Wrap-up was held on Thursday, July 12th, at 7:00 pm in the Newark City Council Chamber on Newark-Elkton Road.

State Senators Steve Amick & Liane Sorenson and State Representatives Pam Maier, Terry Schooley and John Kowalko spoke to and answered questions from constituents about the highlights of this year's legislative session. Areas of interest included the purchase of the Bank of America building adjacent to Rodney Square in Wilmington, Recycling and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA).

Senator Amick, an originator of the event, said, "Every year, I look forward to spending this evening with my constituents. It's important that they understand what we did in Dover that will affect them, and it's important that I know what they expect of me."
