Senator Dori Connor Announces Discovery of Free Life Insurance Program

Senator Dori Connor (R-Penn Acres) recently introduced a Senate Concurrent Resolution to encourage eligible Delawareans to take advantage of the MassMutual Life Insurance Company's LifeBridge Free Life Insurance Program.

As quoted in the Washington Post...sometimes free is really free. The agents writing the policies are doing the work pro-bono and no commissions are paid for these policies. This is a wonderful opportunity for families to ensure their children's education should a tragedy occur."
